

Minutes of the January 19, 2021 SATC Board Meeting:

Present via the ZOOM application over the internet were Dawn Warden, Kevin Dunleavy, Gail Brossman, Gary Labelle, Bob Keen, Tim Younes, Rob Shaw, Andrea Viazanko, and Mark Press.

After review, the Board voted to approve the minutes of the October 6, 2020 meeting.

In addition to the written report, the Treasurer reported that a detailed budget was not being presented at this time because Covid19 pandemic restrictions resulted in uncertainty in regard to when and if the banquet, picnic and Christmas party would be held.

The President reported the following:

An ATC staff member indicated that the 225 parking lot work will occur before the end of the year.

The Central Pennsylvania Conservancy is planning to run both the 15 and 50 kilometer Iron Master Challenges on 9/26/21.

The Keystone Trails Association is planning on conducting the Super Hike on 9/11/21. Also, as the result of a generous bequest from the estate of Mr. Richard Heimenz, the KTA now has an endowment, and the KTA is setting up an annual grant to assist member clubs in financing trail related projects.

The board noted that, on behalf of SATC in memory of Carl Lorence, the Club is grateful for Carl's contributions to hiking and trail maintenance.

All board members with expiring terms agreed to serve another term if elected.

The membership will have the opportunity to vote for officers and board members via email.

A hike to Hawk Rock is planned for this year, but there will be no banquet and no meeting due to the Covid19 pandemic restrictions on group congregations.

The board expects to have a summer picnic and a Christmas party.

The Treasurer will prepare a budget and the board will review and vote on the budget via email by the end of April.
